



PEG WALL LAMP

Be sure to **read this quick guide thoroughly before installing your peg wall lamp.**

For the light to hang correctly, the wall must be capable of accepting the rawl plugs without giving way or degrading.

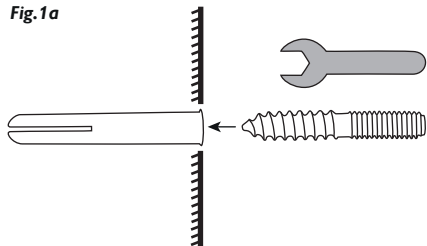

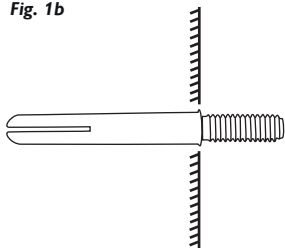
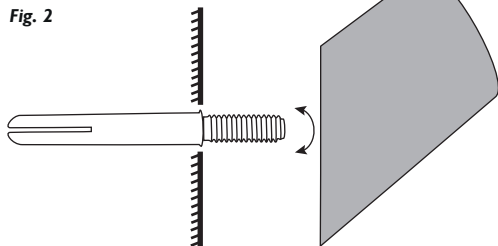

In addition to the screw and rawl plug supplied, you will need:

A 6mm spanner (if the suggested fixings are used)

IMPORTANT: If you are in any doubt, **STOP** and seek professional help.

Installing your peg wall lamp

- 1 Drill a hole into your wall to the depth required for the rawl plug.
- 2 Use a spanner to tighten the first part of the screw into the rawl plug, making sure you leave half of the smooth surface of the screw showing. See *Fig. 1a and Fig. 1b*
- 3 Take the wooden peg and screw tightly onto the rest of the screw so that it sits flush against the wall. See *Fig. 2*
4. Gently wrap the cable around the wooden peg to achieve your desired look. We suggest at least four times. See *Fig. 3*
