



PRESERVED PLANTS CARE GUIDE

Caring for your preserved plants

When you first get your preserved plant, carefully remove it from the packaging and place it in your favourite vase. You'll be tempted to give it a quick zhush, but remember that this is a real plant and stop. Give it a few days and it'll naturally settle into its new home.

By following the tips below, your preserved plant will remain beautiful for several years.

Your preserved plant

- This 100% natural preserved plant is suitable for indoor use only.
- To keep it in tip top condition, avoid touching it as much as possible.
- To dust, very gently shake the plant, or blow with a hair dryer on a cool setting.
- Spritzing your plant with perfume or scented products can damage it.
- Position it out of direct sunlight to avoid colour fading.
- Place away from heat sources such as radiators and fireplaces.
- Your preserved plant loves staying dry so remember not to water it.
- The recommended humidity level is below 70%. If your plant gets damp it may transfer colour onto porous surfaces.
- Protect any polished or painted surfaces it's standing on.
- Keep out of the reach of children - small parts can cause a choking hazard if accidentally swallowed.
- Due to very small quantities of glycerin, this non-toxic preserved plant is biodegradable but not compostable.
