



Fern Bubble Chandelier

WARNING Never take risks with electrical safety. Always disconnect the mains power before beginning any electrical work and test that it is isolated - it is NOT enough just to turn off the light switch. Electrical products must be installed in accordance with IET regulations (BS 7671). If you are in any doubt, always consult a qualified electrician or an experienced person registered with an electrical Competent Person Scheme. Further information is available online or from your Local Authority. If the lighting circuit is not protected by a Residual Current Device (RCD) then the installation should be carried out and tested by a qualified electrician. If necessary, use a suitable stepladder, but first read the useful advice given by the Health and Safety Executive. Visit www.hse.gov.uk and search for 'using stepladders'.

Before you start, please note the following:

- Locate the M screws and T-bar hooks, screwing them together
- Cable 1 doesn't need a hook installing
- Secure the paper template with a light tack/masking tape
- We recommend using a 6mm drill bit for installing the 6mm rawl plugs
- In the how-to installation video, the light is installed on an MDF board where no plugs are required
- Once the light is in place, remove stickers and cable markers

Installing your pendant light

Step One

Stick the paper template to the ceiling, lining up the front arrows.

Step Two

Following the angle of stem B, measure the specified distance outwards from the ceiling rose, marking with the supplied green dot. Drill, plug and repeat for the other two ferns.

Step Three

Following the angle of cable 8, use the supplied corresponding numbered sticker to mark the distance indicated by the tape on the cable.

Step Four

Drill and plug the hole, then screw in a t-bar hook.

Step Five

Loop cable 8 securely around the t-bar hook. Repeat steps three to five for all cables except cable 1.

Step Six

Screw a t-bar hook into the pre-drilled holes marked with a green dot and hang the ferns by looping them around it.

Step Seven

Screw in the first bulb

Step Eight

Carefully hook the glass baubles, starting at the bottom and working upwards. See fig. 1-4 overleaf for reference.

Step Nine

Repeat for all cables except cable 1, which has no glass baubles. Switch on!

Fitting the glass baubles to your pendant light

1. Insert your bulb into the bulb holder before adding the glass baubles.
2. Take your first glass bauble and position it over the metal hook. See Fig. 1
3. Gently slide the glass bauble over the metal hook. See Fig. 2
4. Do not let the glass bauble drop into place, glide it there carefully. See Fig. 3
5. Once in position, add the next glass bauble onto the opposite metal hook. This will balance the structure and avoid any breakages. See Fig. 4
6. Repeat steps 2 - 5 until all the glass baubles have been arranged.

Note: When changing the light bulb we would recommend you remove the glass baubles. This will avoid breakages.

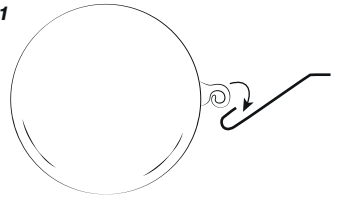

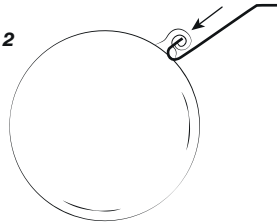

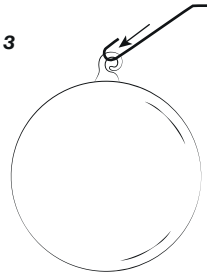
